Meeting Your Goals For The Transition To AS9100C

AS9100 Transition Information:

- All companies should acquire (at minimum) the following documents:
AS9100C & AS9101D
- The documents can be purchased from sae.org
- The transition period officially begins with auditor training on May 1, 2010
- AS9100 audits after **July 1, 2011** must be to AS9100C
- Companies that are currently certified to AS9100B, and are interested in maintaining their certification, must transition to AS9100C no later than **July 1, 2012**
- AS9100B will expire on July 1, 2012

Meeting Your Goals For The Transition To AS9100C

- Based upon the release of IAQG transition documentation, upgrading to AS9100C will begin on/around September 2010, additional audit time will be necessary
- All organizations must still meet the requirements of AS9100B until their AS9100C audit
- Please contact KEMA by June 1, 2010 regarding your transition plans

Meeting Your Goals For The Transition To AS9100C

- Your organization must:
 - Complete one full internal audit cycle including effective closure of all nonconformities to all requirements of AS9100C (except approved exclusions)
 - Complete at least one management review where you have claimed and clearly state in your management review records that your system meets AS9100C requirements and is ready for KEMA to perform the upgrade audit to AS9100C
 - Ensure appropriate personnel are competent on these new requirements, including training of internal auditors
- Organizations must provide KEMA with a written declaration of conformity to AS9100C prior to KEMA conducting AS9100C audits
