As a Registry-recognized Verification Body you will now have access to the Climate Registry Information System (CRIS). Within the next day, you should receive your CRIS user name and password via e-mail, along with instructions for providing CRIS access to verifiers in your firm. KRQ is responsible for uploading verification statements and completing the verification module in CRIS for any Members for which it completes verification activities.

We look forward to working with KRQ for many years to come. We hope KRQ will participate in the Voices of Experience section of upcoming Prepare for Verification webinars. As always, we encourage you to contact The Climate Registry to provide feedback on our program, including the accreditation process, our protocols, and other tools.
